Remarks: Entries will be made by team. National teams, regional teams, club teams and mixed teams are entitled to start. A team consists of 3 or 4 riders. In all age groups, the teams may consist of mixed teams of female and male participants (ratio arbitrary) in the corresponding age groups. Female U17 riders can be integrated equally in the U15 teams. Female riders who are not part of a team will register with the organiser and will be assigned to a mixed team.

No entry fee will be charged.

Riders of the following categories may participate in the Tour de Berlin

U 13 m/f age groups 2010, 2011


U 15 m/f age groups 2008, 2009

U 17 f age groups 2006, 2007

may participate. The tour will be run according to the rules of the UCI and the BDR and these special regulations.

Remarks: Start numbers will be issued to teams before the start of the 1st stage. Transponders and start numbers will be handed out team by team after the last race.

The team manager meeting for all classes will take place on 19/8/22 at 1:00 pm in the starting area of the 1st stage.

Material regulations:

For all stages the material regulations of the competition regulations for road cycling of the BDR (https://static.rad-net.de/html/verwaltung/reglements/wb-strasse_2022_v2.pdf) point 4.2 paragraph 2; paragraph 4 and 4.3 paragraph 4 must be observed.

In case of violation, 2 penalty seconds will be imposed for each kilometer ridden.

BDR Material Regulations 4.2

In the female and male junior categories young riders (U17, U15, U13) the use of the following materials is generally not permitted, even in time trial.

- wheels with less than 12 spokes and disc wheels
- so-called horn, delta or triathlon handlebars
- Handlebar attachments of any kind

If morphologically necessary, 24-inch wheels with at least 24 spokes may be used in the U15 and U13 age groups.


Material regulations of the BDR 4.3 (paragraph 4)

Permitted maximum gear ratios:

- U 13 5.66 m
- U 15 6.10 m
- U 17 6.10 m

Only the length of the run-off is decisive for the verification of the gear ratio limitations. The run-off length is the distance covered by a wheel in one complete crank revolution.

If larger gear ratios would be possible on the road bike used, the maximum permissible gear ratio can be adjusted by a mechanical blockade. However, simply blocking the smaller sprockets (larger ratios) by means of an adjusting screw is not permitted due to the risk of manipulation.

The gear ratio and wheel control for each rider will be carried out in the individual time trial and team time trial before the start. In the mass start competitions, the first 20 of each race immediately after the finish.

As the U17f riders are integrated into U15m/f teams, the U15m/f gear ratio restriction also applies to them.

The competition jerseys:

- **Yellow** - jersey for the overall leader(s) in each class, i.e. 5 jerseys for U13m, U13f, U15m, U15f and U17f.

- **Green** - jersey for the sprint leader in each class, also 5 jerseys.

- **White** - jersey for the best of the younger age group in the overall classification, 5 jerseys.

- **Red** - jersey for the most combative or fairest rider(s) of the race day. One girl and one boy will be honored per race day across all classes, 2 jerseys per race day.

If a rider leads in more than one classification, the order of classification will be: Yellow - Green - **White** - These leading jerseys must be worn on the next stage. The red jersey may be worn on the next stage. If the leader(s) in the junior jersey (white) or sprint jersey (green) have a higher value jersey, the next best in the special classification will wear the leader's jersey as a substitute on the next stage.



Ranking overview:

Overall rankings in all classes for individual, sprint and junior (younger age group). The overall individual classification is based on time. In the race on Karl-Marx-Allee (full stage) there will be 10, 6 and 3 bonus seconds credited for the top three finishers (only top 3 of the race, not for every age group). In the mass start races at Tempelhof and the Olympic Stadium (half stage) there will be 6, 4 and 2 bonus seconds credited. Additionally, in all mass start events there will be time bonus sprints with 3, 2 and 1 seconds to be won.

The overall leader's jersey will be awarded on the first race day only after the circuit race. On the second day of the race it will be awarded after the individual time trial and the circuit race. The team classification will also be based on time, but for each stage the time of the best three riders of the team will be added together. Time credits are not included in the team classification. For the team time trial, the time ridden by the team will be taken into account. The three best teams in each of the classes U13 and U15+U17w will be honored as overall team winners at the end of the tour.

The sprint jersey will be awarded in each class. For this purpose, there will be sprint rounds in the circuit races, where the first four riders will win 5-3-2-1 points each, regardless of gender. Each point won is included in the sprint classification. In the race on Karl-Marx-Allee, the first rider of each lap will receive 2 points, the second rider 1 point for the points classification, regardless of gender. In addition, only in this race do the classification points go directly into the overall classification with a time credit of 2 and 1 second. In the mass start races there will be 12-8-5-3-2-1 points for the first-placed at the finish. After each stage, the leader in the sprint classification will receive the green jersey and wear it on the next stage.

The green jersey will be awarded on the first day only after the circuit race and on the second day only after the sprint eliminator and the circuit race.

In each class, the best young rider will be awarded the white jersey. The best young female rider is the rider with the highest individual ranking among all riders of the younger age group in the respective class. The white jersey will be awarded on the first day only after the circuit race and on the second day only after the individual time trial and after the circuit race.

For each stage, the most combative or fairest rider(s) will be chosen by the jury and awarded the red jersey (one red jersey will be awarded per race day among all male participants and one red jersey among all female participants). The jersey may be worn on the next stage.

Additional regulations:

In the mass start competitions, there will be a registration check before the start, which will be closed 10 minutes before the start.


Electronic devices for communication (e.g. radio) are prohibited.

Accompanying motor vehicles are only permitted in the team time trial. The drivers of an accompanying motor vehicle must be in possession of the sporting director's license.

Permitted material changes and regulations concerning lap compensation in case of a crash or defect will be communicated by the jury directly before the respective stage.

If a rider cannot finish a stage due to a crash or defect, he/she will be classified in the daily classification with a time of 120% of the time of the last of his/her race and may start in the next stage. During the last stages, riders who are about to lose a lap in the first 2/3 of the race (U13 - 10 laps, U15 - 15 laps) will be taken out of the race and scored as described above.

In case of a crash or defect in the last 3 km in the mass start competitions, the athlete concerned will receive the riding time from the group he/she was in.

The stages

Friday, 19/8/2022 Tempelhof Flugfeld

Stage 1a) Team time trial

Start/Finish: Tempelhofer Flugfeld landing strips

Route: On Tempelhofer Flugfeld, 1 lap = 4km

2:00 pm U13m/f TTT 2 laps = 8km
3:00 pm U15m/f + U17f TTT 3 laps = 12km

The time of the third rider will be taken into account as the team time. Award ceremony for the first three teams directly after the race.

For the individual classification the time of the rider will be included in the team time. Riders who are more than 30 seconds behind their team time will receive their individual time for the overall classification.

No award ceremony for the leaders in the individual classification after the TTT.

Stage 1b) Loop race


4:45 pm - U13m/f 4 laps= 16km, three sprint laps awarding 5, 3, 2, 1 point each, after 1, 2 and 3 completed laps
Time bonus sprint after 2 completed laps: 3,2,1sec

5:30 pm - U15m/f + U17f 7 laps = 28km,
Four sprint laps awarding 5,3,2,1 point each, after 1,2,3 and 5 completed laps
Time bonus sprint after 4 completed laps: 3,2,1sec

Finish time bonus for first three riders: 6,4,2sec. Points green jersey: 12-8-5-3-2-1

Award ceremony for the first three riders in each class. Leading jerseys in all classifications will be awarded according to the classification overview.

Saturday, 20/8/2022 Race day at the Olympic Stadium

Stage 2a) Individual time trial

Start/Finish: Olympic Square

Route: Around the Olympic Stadium 1 lap = 4km

11:00 am all classes ITT 1 lap = 4km

The start will be in starting groups regardless of the overall classification.
The starting order will be announced when the numbers are handed out.
The times achieved will be taken into account for the individual and team classification.

The leader's jerseys will be awarded after the individual time trial according to the classification overview.

Stage 2b) Sprint Eliminator

The race will take place on the Olympic Square on a course of approx. 300m.

1:00 pm U13m, U13f, U15m, U15f, U17f separately 1 run = 300m

Each class will be raced separately. Each heat has a maximum of 8 riders. For each heat, half of the starting field will qualify for the next round.

Example 1: 7 riders are entered in the U17w class: 1 round = final with all riders.

Example 2: in the U13m class 24 riders are entered: 3 rounds: 4x quarter finals with 6 riders each, 4x semi finals with 6 riders each, 1x final with 6 riders.


In the final the 6 best riders in their class will receive the following points for the sprint jersey: 12-8-5-3-2-1 points. If there are only 5 riders at the start, the last point will be omitted.

The race classification will be announced after the individual time trial.

Stage 2c) Loop race

2:30 pm U13m/f 5 laps = 20km, three sprint laps awarding 5, 3, 2, 1 point each,
after 1, 2 and 4 completed laps
Time bonus sprint after 3 completed laps: 3,2,1sec

3:30 pm U15m/f + U17f 8 laps = 32km ,
Four sprint laps awarding 5,3,2,1 point each,
after 1,3,5 and 7 completed laps
Time bonus sprint after 4 completed laps: 3,2,1sec

Finish time bonus for first three riders: 6,4,2sec. Points green jersey: 12-8-5-3-2-1

Awarding of the leader's jerseys after the race according to the classification overview.

Sunday, 21/8/2022 Karl-Marx-Allee

Stage 3) Loop race

Start/Finish: Karl-Marx-Allee, in front of the International Cinema

Route: on Karl-Marx-Allee between Otto-Braun-Straße and Strausberger Platz
1 lap = 1.4km

11:00 am U13m/f 15 laps = 24km,
Three time bonus sprints each: 3,2,1sec after 4,8 and 12
completed laps.

12:00 am U15m/f + U17f 22 laps = 35.2km,
Three time bonus sprints each: 3,2,1sec after 6,11 and 16
completed laps

The first lap is neutral. After that each lap 2-1 points for the first two riders (no extra award for female riders) towards the point classification. Points will be awarded to the first two riders at the finish.

Afterwards, there will be a joint award ceremony for all classes, approx. 1:30 pm. In the event of a tie in the individual classification, the 1/10 and 1/100 in the individual time trial will decide the placement. In the event of a tie in the team classification, the better result of the team time trial will decide the placement. In the event of a tie in the sprint jersey, the better result in the sprint eliminator will decide the placing; if this is also the same, the better placing in the overall individual classification will decide.

Awards

Lead jerseys will be awarded as described in section "Scoring Overview".

Team classification

Medals (gold, silver, bronze) for all participants of the winning teams. One "Buddy Bear" for each winning team.

Individual classification

Berlin Bear for the first three places in each class.


Sprint classification/youth classification
